



## **Year 12 Business Management**

*~Examination Information~*

The 2009 Year 12 Business Management examination is on **Friday November the 13<sup>th</sup> 3.00-5.15pm.**

### End-of-Year Examination:

Students will be required to respond to a series of questions related to Unit 3 and 4.

The examination paper may include questions which refer to stimulus material such as newspaper articles, extracts from reports or case study material.

Students will not be required to use information and communications technology in the examination.

The examination will be set by a panel appointed by the Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority.

The examination paper will be in the form of a question and answer book. The number of lines provided after each question, together with the number of marks allocated, will indicate the appropriate length of response. All questions are compulsory.

The examination is a total of 60 marks and contributes to 50 percent of your study score.

### Content:

All outcomes in Unit 3 and 4 will be examined. All of the key knowledge and skills that underpin the outcomes in Units 3 and 4 are examinable.

The examination will address all of the criteria. All students will be examined against the following criteria.

1. Knowledge of key terms and concepts
2. Understanding of management styles, skills and roles and their application to management contexts.
3. Application of current examples, issues and developments in the management of large-scale organisations in Australia.
4. Analysis of management practices and processes within large-scale organisations in relation to the human resource management function and/or the operations management function and/or change management.
5. Evaluation of effective management responses relating to the human resource function and /or change management.
6. Application of management theory to evaluate alternative management strategies.
